COMMITTEE REPORTS

AT/Executive: none

- **Outreach: Robert** - group sits weekly at Harry's place. Day sits happening monthly in Duncan. There were approximately 23 students for the October 10th one day course held at Dhamma Modana
- There has been a one day course held in Victoria in November and December.

The hall currently used for day sits has been scheduled for our use for January through to May and then from September to December

Building: Carl

1- Mid way along the driveway to the dhamma hall, Bob Simpson put in culvert and built up the height the road surface, it is working well. He also dealt with some erosion caused by rain runoff nearby the bridge. Cost: \$550.

2- The wooden gate on the bridge was cut with a chainsaw allowing someone to enter the property. It was evident they were driving around the dhamma hall, although nothing was harmed I still made a report to the LC RCMP.

3- There are a few other drainage problems. Can we live with them for now?

4- The CVRD asked if we could provide a few pictures of the dhamma hall. Perhaps consider inclusion of a proposed site plan for 75 person Center. "Let's discuss at the trust meeting"

5- A member of the bldg com attended a course at Dhamma Kunja, reporting "positive impressions of the new men's accommodation building". The cost for the 32 person bldg was \$80-90/sq ft.

6 – The following was copied from an e-mail that Carl had sent out to the building committee in December of 09.

"I felt I needed to talk with Brian Duncan (chief bldg insp for CVRD). It was with him in a discussion that I got permission for us to build a temporary hall. Today I told him briefly what we built including that there was no insulation or wiring, just a basic shell. He said, "seasonal"? I said yes but that we were presently putting in a woodstove. I had brought my camera with some pictures inside and out to show him but instead he asked to bring in some prints to put in their file.

I said I was talking with him now because we would like to add an insulated ceiling. He replied, "no it sounds too much like a "permanent temporary" building.

So a ceiling is a no-go. I was pretty sure that's the understanding he and I had, we had talked basic building. With the stove, we are just fine".

- Development of the 60 acres - are we ready to let go of 60 acres and if so what do we want to do it? - Evie

Evie provided an overview of what we have looked at previously. She briefly provided an overview of our visit to Elkington Estates and a follow-up conversation with Doug Makaroff.

There followed a general discussion by many members as well as e-mail's provided by Steve and Bill. The consensus is that we do not consider developing the 100acres. Bob expressed that there is a "real concern" with the potential development on the Hancock property located on our northern boundary. Doug suggested that our efforts would be better placed by focusing on enhancing our web site.

- Shawnigan lake as a prospect for a fall course – Evie

Evie checked with Penny Pope – we could possibly have the space for the fall. They are under construction at this time. The new changes may not be suitable for our needs. It is unknown at this time if they will allow us to cook our own meals. They will contact Evie in January with a response.

- Harry will be the coordinator of a non-center committee looking for a location for a fall course.

- Duncan day sitting Dana being collected at day sits - Harry and Carl will open up a bank account for depositing anonymous donations (in small amounts). Students requesting a receipt will have one mailed to them.

Any monies issued with tax receipt will be given to Hope.

Suggested we move the 100,000.00 into a term deposit. Hope will research options available.

Carl suggested we hold off at this time and look at the overall plan first.

Decision was made to just leave it where it is at this time.
